The safety and protection of the children, youth and vulnerable individuals in our care is a primary focus of Cornerstone Church Chrisney, Chrisney, Indiana (CCC) as we commit to sharing the love of Jesus Christ to all individuals in our care. This includes the physical safety as well as the emotional well being of all persons. In an attempt to achieve this standard, it is the policy of CCC that classes or events sanctioned or held by CCC shall meet the below criteria:

- The event or class must be supervised by at least two staff or volunteer persons that have undergone criminal background checks per the CCC's Policy on Requirements of Staff and Volunteers of CCC.
- The event or classes shall be held in a church area that is easily viewed from outside the event room. Closed classroom doors must have a glass panel that allows easy viewing from the outside or the door must remain open.
- Emergency telephone numbers shall be readily available and posted by the kitchen wall telephone in case of a medical or fire emergency.
